Due to some questions received at the HCBC office we would like to clarify how this affects your current membership, insurance and services.

- The same services offered by HCBC in 2010 remain in place with the exception of Equine Canada licensed competitions.
- Your HCBC membership benefits remain unchanged. The insurance is valid and will continue to offer you exceptional coverage for whichever equine activity you participate in.
- HCBC individual memberships still remain a requirement for all HCBC Clubs and Affiliates that take part in Capri insurance programs.
- Facilities and clubs hosting competitions may at their discretion require participants to hold an HCBC individual membership to reduce their exposure to liability.
- HCBC is the only membership required for HCBC General Performance competitions.
