Livingstone (Hank) is a 14-year-old BC bred thoroughbred gelding, owned by Gerry and Hawley Bennett of Langley, BC. He was bred in Langley by Dr. Bryan Anderson. Hawley purchased Livingstone when she was 17 years old and Livingstone was 4 and together they have done wonderful things. Their early success included 1998 Canadian Eventing Team Long List based on her outstanding results at the North American Young Riders Championship where she finished fourth individually. They were on the Pan Am Event team that earned a silver medal at the 2003 games. They placed top Canadian at the Rolex event in Kentucky. Recently he went to the 2004 Olympic Games and placed a creditable 64th in a talented international field. Not bad for a Langley bred thoroughbred! Hawley is committed to her horse and they are a close knit team. Hawley says "I wouldn't change a thing. I have had big offers for him, but I couldn't sell my dreams and my friend. I know him so well - I know all his quirks, I know when I walk into the barn what I'm going to get that day." Livingstone is the 2004 Horse of the Year for HCBC.
