HORSE COUNCIL BC EVENT PERMIT

Event/Competition

❖ **Permit Fees:**

All Shows Permit Fee \$35.00 + HST = \$ 39.20 per Day (s) of Competition. No limit per number of days.
Prize list/premium/entry form must be submitted to HCBC 30 days in advance of public distribution

- ❖ HCBC membership required for competitors, officials and show manager
- ❖ All protests handled by HCBC competition committee
- ❖ Horse Council BC GP Rule book, and or club (facility) rules may apply and must be stated in Prizelist.
- ❖ HCBC General Performance rule book is available online at www.hcbc.ca \ Competitions.



BC Heritage Qualifier

- ❖ A show must offer a minimum of two BC Heritage classes. Additional existing classes can be designated as BCH_at no extra cost.
- ❖ BC Heritage Classes are: Showmanship, Western Pleasure, Western Equitation, Command Class, Western Horsemanship, Reining, Trail, Pole Bending, Barrel Racing, Stake Race and Keyhole Race. English Showmanship, English Pleasure, Hunt Seat Equitation, Hunter Under Saddle, Hunter Hack, Road Hack, Show Hack, Handy Horse, Hunters and Jumpers over Fences 2' – 3' 6" Divisions, Dressage Training & First Levels, Driving Reinmanship, Working Pleasure, Games
- ❖ BCH classes must be clearly identified in prize list and/or entry form
- ❖ Competitors require a Log Book to record qualifying results (available from HCBC)
- ❖ Organizers are responsible for submitting results sheets to HCBC
- ❖ Organizers are responsible for validating competitor's Log Books
- ❖ Certified Provincial, Breed, or Discipline officials may be used.
- ❖ **EXCEPTION:** a knowledgeable person may be used with an approved Guest Card.
Show Organizers should complete the HCBC Guest Card Application form posted under Show Organizers or Contact the HCBC office for information on obtaining a Guest Card Application form
