## HORSE COUNCIL BC Recognized Events Sanctioning

### EVENT/COMPETITION

- **Permit Fees:** Permit Fee \$ 39.20 per Day(s) of event includes GST. No limit per number of days.
- Draft Prize list, entry form, waiver must be submitted to HCBC 30 days in advance of public distribution.
- HCBC membership is required for all riders, owner or guardian of Junior exhibitors for insurance purposes.
- Horse Council BC Rule Book governs the competition. Local rules may be applicable, however, must be stated in Prize list.

# BC HERITAGE CIRCUIT CHAMPIONSHIPS

### BC HERITAGE QUALIFIER

- A show must offer a minimum of two BC Heritage Circuit classes
- BC Heritage Classes are: Showmanship, Western Pleasure, Western Equitation, Command Class, Western Horsemanship, Trail Horse, Pole Bending, Barrel Racing, Stake Race and Keyhole Race. English Showmanship, English Pleasure, Hunt Seat Equitation, Hunter Under Saddle, Hunter Hack, Road Hack, Show Hack, Handy Horse, Hunters over Fences 2' – 3' 6" Divisions, Jumper 2" – 3'6" Divisions. Dressage Training & First Levels, Western Dressage, Driving Reinsmanship, Working Pleasure Driving, Command Driving, Arena Driving Trials, Field Driving Trials
- Certified Provincial Officials, Breed, or Discipline Officials may be used and listed on application for approval.
- Where Certified Officials are not available, a knowledgeable industry professional may serve as Official with a Guest Card application submitted with event application by organizer for approval 30 days prior to event organizers should complete the Recognized Event Application, Certificate of Insurance, Draft Prize List and Include permit fee of \$39.20 per day to HCBC for approval 30 days prior to event for posting on the HCBC Calendar of Competitions. Applications received less than 30 days may be accepted however may not be listed on the Competition Calendar in sufficient time to maximize competitor entries in your event. Show Package forms are emailed to Organizers prior to the competition. A Competition ID Report is all that is required for Organizers to submit by email following the recognized event competition.
