

Horse Council BC Zone 1 Grant Funding Criteria.

Horse Council BC and Zone 1 are committed to education, fostering participation, growth, development, and excellence in all horse related sport and industry activities, while preserving valued horse traditions.

Funding policy and criteria:

Clubs, organizations and individuals that are current paid up members of HCBC and reside in Zone 1 may apply for Zone 1 funding.

Zone 1 makes grants to clubs, organizations and individuals that demonstrate that they give, or are planning to give substantial benefit to Zone 1 horse persons in the areas of education, participation and skill development.

Members may apply at any time during the year for Zone funding grants, however Zone 1

*resources are limited and cannot meet every need. Applications from any club, organization or individual **should** not exceed **\$250** in any one year.*

Grant applications for clinics: preference will be given to those hiring coaches or instructors that are certified and/or recognized by HCBC and/or Equine Canada.

Grant applications will not be considered after the event has taken place.

Grants must be spent solely for the purpose for which they are given and within the

financial year – they must not be added in whole or part to reserves. Grants will not be

considered for administration or operating costs of a club, organization or individual.
