



Notice to all Equestrian Competitors,

To promote proper vaccination protocols, all horses entering competition at the 55+ Games must have been administered Equine Influenza and Equine Herpes (EHV-1,EHV-4) vaccinations. No horse shall have received the vaccination within 7 days prior to arriving at the competition.

It is recommended that the vaccinations be administered by a veterinarian. Competition management may request supporting documentation confirming these vaccination requirements.

At the discretion of Competition Management, horses not in compliance may be asked to leave the competition without reimbursement.

If a horse is unable to receive either of these vaccinations, a letter signed by a veterinarian stating that the horse can not be vaccinated due to medical concerns must accompany the competitors' entry form. Bio-security planning helps to ensure that practices routinely carried out on the farm or at competition are beneficial to your horses health.

By adopting proper bio security protocols and working with your veterinarian you can play a significant role in keeping your horses and the Equine Industry as healthy as possible.
